FFAM – EUROPEAN RULES

1- FFAM competition passport (free)

The passport is ordered by the organizer. You don't need to do anything, all the necessary information is in the registration form.

2- UAS Operator code :

With the Européan drone régulations (EASA), all pilots in Europe must have a UAS Operator code. This code is valid for all your models <800g.

French : The UAS number is mandatory to validate the license, remenber to display it on the model.

European Union country : Each European countries has registration platforms to obtain this UAS code. You must check its expiry date and display the code ont the model.

Example :

France → AlphaTango

Germany → Luftfahrt-Bundesamt

Spain → AESA

Italy → D-Flight (ENAC)

....

Non-European Union country

- If you have already participated in a competition in Europe, you must have (ou should have) registered to obtain this UAS code. If it has not expired, this code is valid for all European countries. Display the code on the model
- If you don't have a UAS Operator code please refer to the attached document :

Reminder : Altitude logger measurements are not accepted to correct the time stopped by the timekeeper when flying out of sight as european regulations prohibit flying out of sight.

Each participants needs a valid FAI-sporting licence 2026

LOCAL RULES - DEVIATIONS FROM SPORTING CODE

- Maximum 5 people per starting point.
- F1Q class starts with 2 joules.
- it is now impossible to find enough timers for the competition :
 - o Each competitor must be timed by another competitor in their group.
 - o No simultaneous flying in the start group is permitted during the scoring run.
 - o Binoculars and a stopwatch will be available at each starting point.
 - o The timekeeper must record the competitor's time on the starting point's sheet before the end of the round. (the score cards are collect at the end of each round)
 - o There will be a few official timekeepers walking the line to check compliance to the rules, double check the flight time duration...
- For the fly-off each competitor must provide the name of a timekeeper.
The competitor's starting pole is drawn at random, and his timekeeper will be assigned to the next starting pole.

PROTEST

The fee for a protest is 50.00€ and must be deposit with the written protest in French or English language.
